- Past high profile incidents involving MSPs
- Federal entity involvement
 - EU (NIS2 Directive)
 - UK (CAF Compliance)
 - USA, AUS, CAN, etc?
- Client's want to know that they are being protected
 - Cellular Provider Breaches
 - Media Coverage that is hitting to close to home

- Change in Priorities
 - Having better cybersecurity conversations with clients

- Make MSPs Cyber Ready, Cyber Aware, Cyber Resilient
- Cybersecurity is ever changing getting to Cyber Resilient is an ongoing journey that requires continuous learning.
- 18% of attendees now have a role specific to Cybersecurity
 - CISO/CIO 38%, Cyber services 33%, Delivery Manager 10%
 And SOC/IR Analyst 18%
